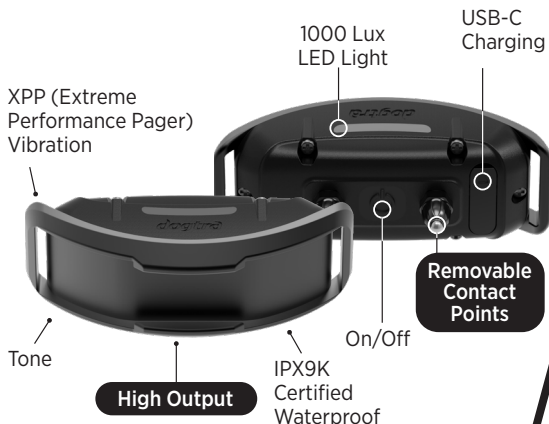


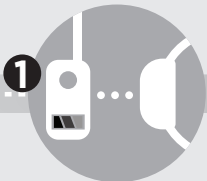

HERE IS OUR CHECKLIST FOR YOU TO START



1 Always double check your battery life and connection of the unit



2 Pass the strap through the left, center, and right loops according to the direction of the arrow and fasten it



3 The best position is on either side of the dog's neck. Ensure a snug fit making skin contact*

5 Make sure your dog understands commands before layering the e-collar over



4 Know your dog's conditioning level**

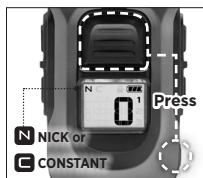


TURNING THE UNIT ON/OFF



The remote transmitter's power button is located on the bottom right. The receiver's collar power button is located between the contacts. Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn it on or off. The LED indicator will turn solid green with a tone when the unit powers on and a red light with a tone when it powers off. (Press the power button briefly to turn on the backlight.)

- Green Full charge
- Amber Medium charge
- Red Needs charge



PROGRAMMING BETWEEN NICK AND CONSTANT

- Set the stimulation level to "0".
- Hold both the main front button and side power button together for 5 seconds to program Nick or Constant mode. The selected mode will be displayed on the top of the LCD screen.

SIDE BUTTONS



1 Boosted Constant

Boosted Constant button customizes your desired immediate level jump without having to manually increase the level, which can be applied up to 12 seconds. To set up, please follow the below steps:

- Set the level at "0".
- Hold the Boosted Constant button until LED light on the transmitter is blinking.

- Use the rheostat dial to select the Incremental Amount to jump.
- Press the Boosted Constant button again to complete the set up.

1 Example

Selecting "5" as the Incremental Amount for the Boosted Constant button will apply the output level of displayed level + 5, as shown below.

Base Displayed Level	Incremental Amount	Boosted Constant Output
1	+5	6
5	+5	10

Applies Displayed Base Level. In this case, level 5 'Nick' will apply.



Applies 'Boosted Constant' for up to 12 seconds. In this case, level 10 'Constant' will apply.



1 LCD Display

PHONE	PAGER	LIGHT
T-1	P-1	L-1

2 Tone

Emits a beeper tone without applying stimulation for up to 12 seconds.

3 XPP (Extreme Performance Pager) Vibration

Provides a non stimulating vibration for up to 12 seconds.

4 LED Locate Light

- Uses a 1000 lux LED Light on the receiver to locate your dog in the dark.
- For continuous blinking, every 4 seconds, tap the Locate Light button once. To disable the continuous blinking, tap Locate button again.
- To manually enable the continuous blinking, press and hold the Locate Light button which can stay blinking for up to 12 seconds.

SAFETY STIMULATION LEVEL LOCK



To prevent the stimulation level from changing unintentionally, press down the top of the Rheostat dial for more than 2 seconds to lock it. When locked, a lock icon will appear on the LCD screen. To unlock, press down the top of the Rheostat dial for more than 2 seconds.



Stimulation level lock indicator

1-DOG LOCK MODE



- Set the stimulation level to 0, then press and hold all four side buttons simultaneously.
- Continue holding until the LED turns red. After 5 seconds, the on-screen number will disappear, confirming the change.
- In this mode, the remote controls Dog 1 only, regardless of toggle position. Dog 2 and Dog 3 receivers will not respond.
- To unlock, repeat the same steps while in Lock Mode.

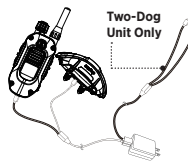
HOW TO ADD ADDITIONAL RECEIVER DEVICES



- Turn on the transmitter and set the stimulation level to "0". Use the toggle to select the desired dog (1,2 or 3).
- To begin pairing receiver must be off. Initiate pairing mode by pressing and holding the power button for 5 seconds until the LED starts blinking and then release.
- Simultaneously press the front transmitter button and side Boost button until the screen reads "CD****" then release. Confirm successful pairing by pressing Pager vibration.

Repeat the pairing process if the pager vibration test is unsuccessful. The pairing between the devices has timed out or failed.

CHARGING THE BATTERY

Use the 2-port USB-C battery charger to charge the receiver and transmitter concurrently. You can use other USB-C cable to charge individually. For optimal performance, only use Dogtra-approved batteries and accessories for your Dogtra e-collars.
